Dear BRAHM Family,







Education & Outreach

From Jennifer Garonzik, Education Center Director:

2017 has been a year of building on solid foundations in our Education Center. We have increased attendance in our weekly art classes for children, Doodlebug Club, and Afternoon Art. This year saw the addition of another grade of students from Blowing Rock School attending our monthly Young at Art program as well. Our summer was full of activity in the Education Center as children from Blowing Rock Parks and Recreation Day Camps were given several opportunities to create in our space. We also hosted workshops and camps for paper sculpture, nature art, and map making with community children.

The continuation of and expansion of adult hands-on opportunities included figure drawing, oil painting, and watercolor classes, as well as face jug sculpting, tablet weaving, and small landscape painting workshops. Our Cork & Canvas sessions continue to bring the joy of making art to the community.

From Willard Watson III, Programs & Outreach Director:

2017 was a delightful year! It was a whirlwind of community activity that included a talk about "Strong Mountain Women: How Ballads Shape a People," led by eighth generation ballad singer Donna Rae Norton, a round table discussion and cheese tasting with local WNC cheese makers, a lecture and reading from award-winning author and illustrator Gail Hailey, and a nine-film movie series that explored the visual arts and Appalachian culture.

Our summer concert series brought world class music to BRAHM's atrium and was packed for musical performances by the classical quartet, the Vivaldi Project, folk duo Zoe & Cloyd, and fiddle player Kevin Burke. We also held a Caroling and Wassailing event led by local Yale trained opera singer, Christy Lombardozzi.

Students from High Country public schools visited for our Free Field Trip Program, which provides free field trips for all Watauga County public schools and school bus reimbursement for the four schools that receive Title I funding.
